### Netball News

On Friday 1st March, our netball team played Lutley Primary School in a home game as part of the Halesowen 7-a-side Netball League. The team won 17 - 1. Well done to all children taking part and thank you to all the family members who came to support the team.

### Dudley Cross Country Championships

Last Saturday morning, children took part in the Dudley Cross Country Championships at Himley Park. Thirty-five schools took part and there were well over 100 boys and 100 girls competing in the event. I am pleased to announce that both our boys and girls teams finished in the top ten - the girls achieving 8th place overall and the boys achieving 7th place. Well done to all the children involved and a big thank you to parents and family members who turned out to support the children. However, a special mention needs to be made to William who finished 6th and will go on to represent Dudley Primary Schools at an Inter-area race to be held after Easter.

### High 5 Netball

On Thursday we entered 3 teams in the Primary High Five Netball Competition at Windsor High School. High 5 netball is played with 7 players with 5 players on court (no wings), and for each match the children have to rotate positions, so they never play the same position during the event.

For the majority of our children, this was their first competitive match and we included eight year 5 pupils. Team C played well, and although they didn't win any matches, they did themselves and the school proud.
