Alex and Persephone have been busy, along with the rest of school council, organising World Book Day.

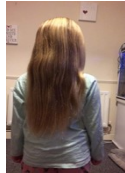
In our previous two newsletters we have let you know which book your child's class will be reading. Children are being encouraged to come to school dressed up as a character from that book.

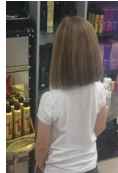
## Charity News—Update
